Club Electric Vehicle Charging Policy

The Club Committee and Lodge Office team has considered the increasing needs of our owners with electric vehicles. This policy covers charging for all vehicles, including camper van batteries etc.

For owners and guests in Lodges 17 – 61, the following rules apply:

- When charging please use the 'Caution trip hazard' sign and IM cable cover. These are available by indicating on your booking form and will be delivered to your lodge upon arrival.
- Please remember your own charging cable, as we are unable to supply cables.
- The vehicle manufacturer's 13amp product must be used in the lodge 13amp sockets and no other adapters/chargers are permitted.
- Under no circumstances can an extension cable or 'daisy chaining' of cables/sockets take place.
- The cost of the electricity will be part of your usual weekly lodge charge.
- Please be aware that the owner of the cable and/or vehicle is the person liable if anyone trips and subsequently claims injury.
- Please note that charging from the Alpine Lodges is not possible, due to guest parking being located too far away from these Lodges to be safe for other guests.
